- A major 'Thought Conclave' was organised on 23rd April 2011 to celebrate fifteen decades of influence of Gurudev Tagore on Indian emancipation.
- 150th Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekanada, a state level multilingual essay competition in English, Konkani and Marathi was held in connection with the workshop "Swami Vivekananda: Realizing Self potential and Redefining Success" on 8 September 2012. Jennifer Furtado (Margao), Veronica Coutinho (Miramar) and Snehal Gurav (Morjim) took away the first three positions and won cash prizes respectively of rupees 4000/-, 3000/-, and 2000/-. Two consolation prizes of Rs. 500/- each were won by Clarissa de Souza (St. Cruz) and Deesha Suresh Patel (Vasco).







- Two-day multi-lingual Theatre festival in DM Hall in Kala Academy on 6 and 7 November 2010. To encourage local talents and to bring Goan artists and those from other states on the same platform to perform, the festival started with a Konkani Tiatr (Matiechem Bhangar Korunk) on 6th November. On 7th November, a Bangla theatre by the artists from National School of Drama, Delhi was presented.
- 3-days Goa-Bengal Festival in food, cuisine, handicrafts, dance, music & literature was held from 22 to 24 April, 2011 at Mandovi Riviera Waterfront, Panaji.
